June & July Updates

- Canfor is to start harvesting in July in the Lovell Cove area.
- A temporary rig camp of less than 25 people will be built at the old Lovell Cove site to facilitate the construction of the B-hill bypass and new camp, tentatively schedules for 2021 as the economic conditions improve. The duration of this camp is to be one year or less.
- Rig camp operation will be contracted to Sasuchan who will ensure local employment opportunities are provided to community members.
- B-hill construction is delayed to 2021.
- Road improve work on the Driftwood mainline, funded by Canfor, will flow to Sasuchan who will contract community-based contractors to execute.
- BCTS spacing project has been tendered and tentatively awarded to a community contractor.
- Driftwood road upgrade project to resume in summer 2020. With a portion managed by Sasuchan, contract work opportunity is made available for community-based contractors.
- Forest consulting companies subcontracted to Sasuchan will be operating throughout the Takla Traditional Territory – Lovell Cove, the Valteau, West Arm.
- Spot road repair projects on the Kemess mine access road will undergo for June and July.

August 2020



- Canfor upgrades to Lovell Cove camp. Harvesting will be happening, causing extra traffic on the FSR; ~25/loads a day.
- Driftwood road project will still be underway.
